HELPFUL INFORMATION

SUPPLY LISTS

STUDENT MASKS/FACE COVERINGS

- 🐾 We received updated health protocols on 7/27/21 stating that all students and staff are required to wear face masks indoors and on CCSD buses. When your child comes through the gate in the morning they do not need to wear a mask as we will be outdoors but they do need to have a mask in hand as they will be required to put it on when they enter the building.

ARRIVAL TIME/DISMISSAL TIME AND PARENT PROCEDURES

- 🐾 For safety reasons, students **must not** arrive to school prior to 7:40 a.m., as there will be no supervision until that time.
- 🐾 Students are dismissed at 2:11 p.m. If a parent needs to check a student out prior to 2:11 p.m., the parent must do so **before** 1:45 p.m. to minimize classroom disruptions.
- 🐾 To ensure student safety and facilitate a smooth morning and afternoon, parents are not permitted to enter the playground or building during drop off and pick up. Please ensure your child enters through their designated grade level gate. In the afternoon, siblings may all leave through the youngest sibling's grade level gate.

MORNING BELL

- 🐾 The first morning bell rings at **7:55 a.m.** During the first two weeks of school, ALL Kindergarten - 5th grade students will line up on their paw on the main playground with their teachers and their teachers will lead them to class. Starting the third week of school, all students will line up on their paw and will be dismissed by staff to go directly to their classroom to meet their teacher for morning choice. ***Students arriving after 8:00 a.m. are tardy.*** Their teachers will log their tardy in Infinite Campus. Pre-K students will have morning recess on the small playground at the front of the school.

ABSENCES

- 🐾 When your child is absent from school for any reason, please send visit <https://www.bonner elementary.com/student-absences-infinite-campus> and complete the form **within three days of the absence**. All pre-arranged absences must be approved prior to the absence by administration. All absences, except due to school activities, affect perfect attendance, regardless of pre-approval or doctors' notes.

DROP OFF ZONES

- 🐾 Parents are encouraged to utilize our DROP OFF ZONES located in the front of the school on Crestdale Lane and on the side of the school on Oxford Cross. The drop-off zones accept students between 7:40 a.m. - 7:55 a.m. Please wait until at least 7:40 a.m. before dropping off your children, as school supervision is not provided prior to this time. **PLEASE PULL YOUR VEHICLE ALL THE WAY FORWARD INTO THE DROP-OFF ZONE** (prior to allowing children to exit your automobile). This avoids having a long line of vehicles, which could ultimately create an unsafe situation in the actual street. For the safety of our students and the entire community, **NEVER ALLOW STUDENTS EXIT YOUR VEHICLE PRIOR TO ENTERING THE DROP OFF ZONE.**

PICK-UP AREAS

- 🐾 The staff at Bonner strives to provide a safe environment for our children. Students in grades K-5 are dismissed at the back of the school from their assigned gates on the playground. **PLEASE DO NOT DOUBLE PARK OR SIGNAL TO YOUR CHILD TO CROSS THE STREET ALONE.** Additionally, please do not access parking lot on Crestdale for pick up and drop off. Parents may use the parking lot on Oxford Cross but must adhere to traffic laws and follow the directions of staff on duty. A crosswalk is available to safely get children across the street. Our students' safety is our top priority.

SAFEKEY PROGRAM

- 🐾 The City of Las Vegas Department offers child care services for Bonner families before and after school (6:30am-8:00am and 2:11pm-6:30pm). For additional information regarding registration and cost of Safekey services, please call (702) 229-3399.

HOT BREAKFAST AND LUNCH

- 🐾 The United States Department of Agriculture will provide free school breakfast and lunch for all students for the 2021-2022 school year. Students are welcome to eat the school lunch or bring their lunch from home.

CELL PHONES

- 🐾 The use of cell phones by students is prohibited during the instructional day. From 7:40 am-2:11 pm, student cell phones must remain off and will be confiscated if they ring or vibrate. Confiscated cell phones will be returned to the parent/guardian only.
